Structure of the article:

- Abstract: from ten to fifteen lines
- Keywords: from 3 to 6
- The article should be divided into sections, and must include with titles and subtitles
- The article must indicate in any of the chapters the objectives, methodology, theoretical references, discussion and/or results
- Reference: APA 6th edition

Editorial proposal:

The book will be published with the editorial label ABYA-YALA-UPS in co-authorship with another publisher and/or member institution of IUS Education Group

Publication norms:

The text must be original and should contribute to some of the aforementioned topics. The length of the article must be from 20 to 25 pages (between 6000 and 8000 words). It must include footnote with the name and last name of the author (s), the institution to which he/she belongs to, and email.

A curriculum profile must be added at the end with a maximum of 10 lines. The letter used must be Times New Roman 12, line spacing 1.5 and 3-cm margins. Non-textual elements (tables, graphs, illustrations) will be inserted during the development of the articles.
